The regular meeting of the St. Joseph County Council was called to order at 7:05 p.m., on October 9, 2012, by the President, Rafael Morton, in the Council Chambers, fourth floor, County-City Building, South Bend, Indiana.

Petitions, Communications & Miscellaneous Matters:

Mr. McCahill moved and was seconded by Mr. Noland to approve the minutes of September 11, 2012 and October 1, 2012. The motion passed by a voice vote; 9-0. No negatives were heard.

Mr. McCahill made the motion to reappoint the Animal Control Commission, Dr. Richard Headley and John Matthys. To the Mishawaka Penn Harris Library Board, Karen Schwartz. To the Onsite Wastewater Advisory Board, Dale DeVon, John Creed, John Linn and Tim Murray. There was a vote; 9-0 with no negatives.

Mr. Noland made a motion for Bill No. 126-12 and 128-12 to be heard and take action tonight. Mr. McCahill seconded this motion, there was a vote; 9-0, no negatives were heard.

Adoption of the St. Joseph County Budget:

BILL NO. 93-12: AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SALARIES AND FIXING THE NUMBERS OF EMPLOYEES OF ST. JOSEPH COUNTY, INDIANA FOR THE YEAR 2013

Peter Mullen, St. Joseph County Auditor, stated that you have a salary ordinance, we will further have an appropriating ordinance and a third ordinance will have a levy ordinance, all tied to the 2013 budget. A tremendous amount of work has been done our budget, not only for you, the nine of you, but for the commissioners, for our office, we have a lot of angst behind us, for the first time we are able to have a very good and very solid budget. A lot of communication between each other, between councilmen with commissioners as well as department heads. The total budget is ninety one million, seven hundred eighty one thousand, zero thirty four dollars of which fifty six million seven hundred and thirty eight six hundred thirty one dollars is from the General Fund, and thirty five million zero forty two four zero three is from Special Funds. The highlight of our budget is two point eight percent growth quotient in our levy. I think one of the most important things of all is, we are giving salary increases to our eleven hundred and thirty nine employees. For those employees under thirty thousand dollars, we have in the budget for a fifteen hundred dollar a year increase, for those between thirty and forty thousand, a twelve hundred dollar increase and for those forty thousand and above, a thousand dollar increase. For part time employees we are giving an additional forty cents an hour. I would like to compliment Teresa Shuter, who has worked incredibly hard to put this together and I don't think anyone could have worked as hard on this, and I want to personally thank her for what you have done. Your approval

for not only this ordinance but the other ordinance is recommended. I think this is the best budget we have had since I have been here.
